EQUIPMENT OPERATOR (TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT)

The Town of Labrador City is currently seeking to employ a temporary Equipment Operator.

Summary

- The Equipment Operator is responsible for operating heavy equipment in a safe and appropriate manner;
- Responsible for operating front end loader, snow blower, forks, sweeper truck, vacuum trucks, steam truck, sewer truck, trackless (blower, blade, sweeper), zoom boom (rental), excavator, water truck, Kubota, dump truck, sand truck;
- The Equipment Operator must also clean, maintain and secure all equipment as directed by legislation, as well as company policies and procedures;
- The Equipment Operator must deal with residents and members of the company in a courteous and respectful manner.

Qualifications:

- Grade 12 Diploma or Equivalent Education;
- Valid Class 03, 05, 08, 09 Driver's License;
- 1000 hours experience;
- Ability to work independently;
- Applicants may be required to take a practical job test;
- Provide Drivers Abstract.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operate Wheel Loader, Suction Sweeper Truck, Municipal Tractor (Trackless), Sand Truck, Dump Truck, Steam Truck, Sewer Truck. Use of various attachments, mainly a detachable Snowblower;
- Operate heavy equipment in compliance with the company's operating safety policies and procedures;
- Load and unload equipment from vehicles and trailers;
- Ensure Town equipment, material, and the work site are maintained, kept clean, and stored in a safe manner;
- Ability to work extended hours, as required;
- Expected to work in a variety of extreme weather conditions;
- Adhere to workplace safety policies, regulations and compliances
- Attend all safety training;
- Communicate any unsafe conditions or accidents/injuries in a timely manner to the Supervisor to facilitate prompt correction or reporting;
- Clean, lubricate and perform other minor maintenance work;

- Check machinery before driving to ensure that mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order;
- Change attachments, make adjustments;
- Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned;
- Other duties include: labour work, water breaks, cement work, road patching, assist in building construction, assist in lawn repairs and maintenance, clean up week, walking trails, reading of commercial water meters, Christmas decorations (create and repair), line painting, hydrant repairs.

Equipment Operator Skills & Competencies

- Inspect equipment before and after use to ensure proper function;
- Hand and foot coordination: Coordinate movements of hands and feet to guide very large machinery in tight places;
- Operation monitoring: Read gauges, dials, and other indicators, and adjust as necessary;
- Interpersonal skills and teamwork: Coordinate activities with those of other workers on busy construction sites;
- Troubleshooting: Be able to detect and fix operating problems.
