The upcoming 65th Labrador West Winter Carnival tickets will go on sales on Saturday, February 28th at noon online. Also, there will be tickets available on Saturday from 12-2 p.m. at the old Reitman's location in the Labrador Mall while supplies last. RJ, our town mascot, will be in attendance during the events.

The Recreation Committee is actively working on a survey to involve residents in local recreation programs. Additionally, they are exploring the possibility of attaching a device to the Jean Lake groomer to create a cross-country ski trail. The committee is also identifying a suitable site for the development of a new basketball court, enhancing recreational facilities in the town.

Congratulations are extended to the athletes representing our town at the upcoming Labrador Winter Games next month.
