## PROTECTION OF WATER SUPPLY REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the powers vested in it under and by virtue of Section 414 (2)(v) of the Municipalities Act, 1999, and all other powers it enabling, the Town Council of the Town of Wabush in regular session convened on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2001, hereby passes and enacts the following regulations for the protection of water supply.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Town of Wabush (Protection of Water Supply Regulations) 2001.
- 2. <u>Interpretations:</u> In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires:
- a) "Act" means The Municipalities Act, 1999.
- b) "Animal" means any domestic animal.
- c) "Council" means the Town Council of the Town of Wabush constituted under the provisions of the Municipalities Act, 1999.
- d) "Reservoir" means the Public Water Supply reservoir of the Town of Wabush.
- e) "Town" means the Town of Wabush as defined by paragraph 2 of Order-In-Council, dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, A.D., 1967 and made under the said Act.
- 2. No person shall be permitted to erect any building or buildings within the immediate area of the reservoir.
- 3. No person shall be permitted to use the waters of the reservoir, for any recreational or commercial purposes.
- 4. No person shall fish in the water of the reservoir.
- 5. No person shall dip, soak, or wash any article of clothing or any utensil or any vehicle in the waters of the reservoir.
- 6. No person shall throw or cause to be thrown waste materials of any kind into the waters of the reservoir.
- 7. No person shall permit any animal of which he/she is the owner to enter the waters of the reservoir.
- 8. The owner of any dead animal found within 152 m of the waters of the reservoir shall remove and properly dispose of such animal within forty-eight (48) hours after he/she has been notified by the Council or otherwise made aware of the death of the animal in such location.

- 9. The cutting of wood in the watershed area is prohibited.
- 10. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these regulations is guilty of an offense as per Section 420(1)(a) and Section 420 (1)(b) of the Municipalities Act, 1999.
- 11. These regulations shall come into effect on the 25th day of April, 2001.
- 12. All previous protections of water supply regulations are hereby repealed.
