Nominations of candidates for election to the Council for the Municipality of Labrador City will be received between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 3rd, 2019, in Council Chambers, Town Hall, 317 Hudson Drive, Labrador City.

Nominations shall be in writing stating the name and civic address of the candidate and shall be signed by the proposer and seconder both of whom shall be present together with the candidate who shall sign the nomination signifying his or her acceptance. In the event that a candidate cannot be present for his/her nomination, the proposer and seconder may complete the required forms declaring the candidate is qualified and accepts the nomination.

Every candidate shall at the time of his or her nomination, deposit with the Returning Officer the non-refundable sum of ten dollars (\$10.00).

The qualifications of a candidate for election to Council are as follows:

- (1) Canadian citizen having acquired the full age of 18 years on or before Election Day;
- (2) Resident of the municipality for a period of 30 days prior to the commencement of the nomination period;
- (3) Not indebted to the municipality for any arrears of taxes or other charges; and
- (4) Not otherwise disqualified under *The Municipal Elections Act*.

- Voter's List: Provincial Voter's List is being used; therefore, if you have reason to believe your name is not recorded correctly, or have recently become eligible to vote in the Labrador City Municipal Election, please contact the Town Hall at (709) 944-2621 prior to September 3, 2019.
- A **Voter** must be Canadian citizen having obtained the full age of 18 years on or before Election Day and a resident of Labrador City for at least 30 days immediately before Election Day.
