Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Town of Labrador City is taking a proactive approach and has decided on the following closures/procedure changes effective immediately:

- a) All Town Offices will be closed to the public; this includes Town Hall, Public Works, Fire Department, Arena); please call **944-2621** for any business related questions you may have and we will be happy to direct your call accordingly (how to obtain a permit, pay bills, etc)
- b) Although the Fire Department will be closed to the public firefighter response services will continue
- c) Council meetings will be closed to the public – we will continue to provide video updates following each meeting via Facebook
- d) The Labrador West Regional Landfill will remain status quo for now as interactions are very limited (procedures will be put in place onsite for any contact that maybe required)
- e) The Town's recreational facilities are closed to the public (this includes Chill's Loop, Harrie Lake Skating Rink, Tanya Lake Walking Trail, and the Dog Park – these areas will not be maintained during this time)
- f) Deliveries to any Town Facility will continue – phone numbers will be posted at each site on how to contact an employee if signature is required
- g) Drop Box will be placed in the lobby area of the Town Hall for any essential documentation that may need to be dropped off
- h) Commissioner for Oath services will no longer be available until further notice

The Town apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause but we feel following COVID-19 protocol and keeping staff and the general public safe is our top priority.
