Labrador City & Wabush, NL, March 16, 2020 – Council wishes to advise residents that we will be closing all recreation facilities effective immediately. Though employees will have access for care and maintenance there will be no further access by the general public.

Arrangements will be made, and times established for refunds if applicable for any programs, birthday parties, etc that may have been previously booked.

Council and Management with both municipalities did not make this decision lightly, however, in light of what is happening around the world and information from our provincial and federal health authorities, we feel this is prudent action to take for our residents and employees well being and safety.

Both municipalities Town Hall and Public Works Department will remain open. However, we are asking the general public to not visit these facilities unnecessarily.
