Fermont, Thursday March 19th – Prime Minister of Québec announced today a new action regarding the movements of people from one region to another.

We ask our citizens to limit their movements to Labrador City and Wabush and to focus on buying locally.

Be also aware that we keep in touch with the leaders of our nearby towns in order to harmonize our actions and limit contacts.

With regard to the non-resident permanent workers, we keep contact with the mining companies, that already took several preventative measures to make sure that their workers do not pose any risk to the population. Be assured that we will keep you informed regarding all developments regarding the situation.

During his press conference, Mr. Legault thanked « those who feed us ». We, in turn, want to sincerely thank the Cooperative des consommateurs, as it made every effort from the beginning and took specific actions to ensure that Fermont population does not lack anything. It is now the responsibility of everyone to respect the actions that are implemented.

Also thanks to all partners who take specific measures to limit contacts and minimize risks and finally to all our Fermont citizens who respect the demands of the government, who limit their movements and who do not gather nor travel if it is not necessary.
