BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Wabush borrow \$1,200,000 from the Bank of Montreal. The term of this loan will be 10 years at an annual interest rate of 2.75% with a 5-year amortization period and monthly payment of \$11,449.32. The purpose of the loan is to finance the Towns portion of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, project #17-GI-20-00084. All in Fayour.
