A special meeting of the Wabush Town Council was held on Thursday, June 24, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Mayor Ron Barron.

DISCUSSION

Special meeting to discuss patching and sidewalk tender TOW-2021-11 as well as the land sale and development of the Industrial Park Lots.

One bid was received for the completion of ten (10) identified patches with a total cost to the Town of \$ 282,313.50. The Town Manager explained that a large amount of work was to take place in the Industrial Park, and that two businesses have already complained about the road conditions in the area.

It was also noted that with on-going projects we will likely not receive Capital Works Funding for the next 2-3 years. All Council were in agreement that the roadwork needed to be done but there were budgetary concerns and member requested more information regarding the Town's current financial position.

Regarding the Industrial Lot Sale & Development, Council agreed to speak with the customer to discuss the proposal.

OTHER BUSINESS

Councillor Curran expressed disappointment that the annual regatta has been cancelled once again.

Deputy Mayor Burke raised concerns regarding the cleanup of the fire site at 2 Anderson.
